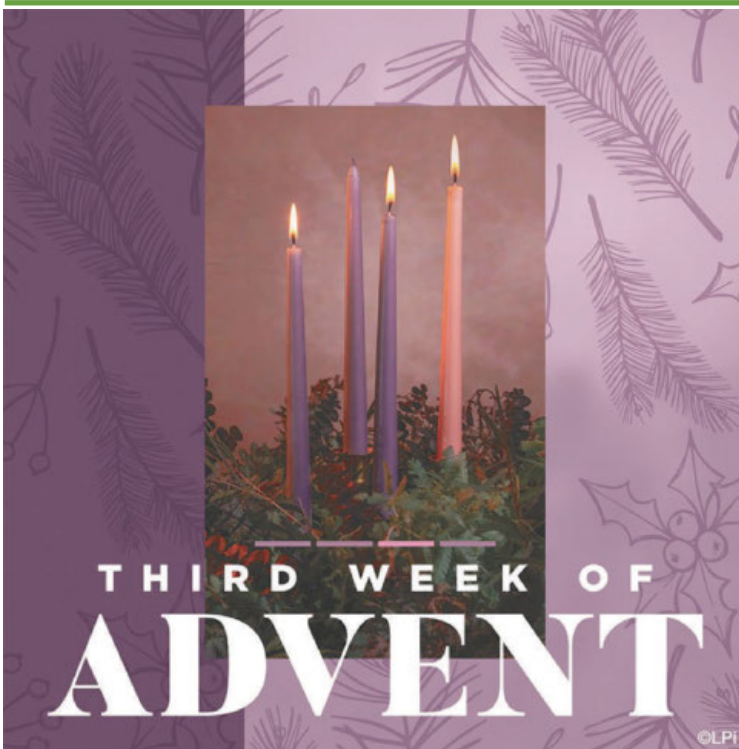

### THE FEAST DAY OF SAINT NICHOLAS

Religious Education catechists, Mrs. Box and Mrs. Clarke, put one of their student's shoes outside of their classroom and waited for Saint Nicholas to bring them all bagged candy treats. The children made Advent chains to complete the day.

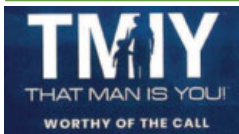

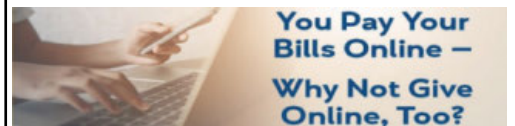
