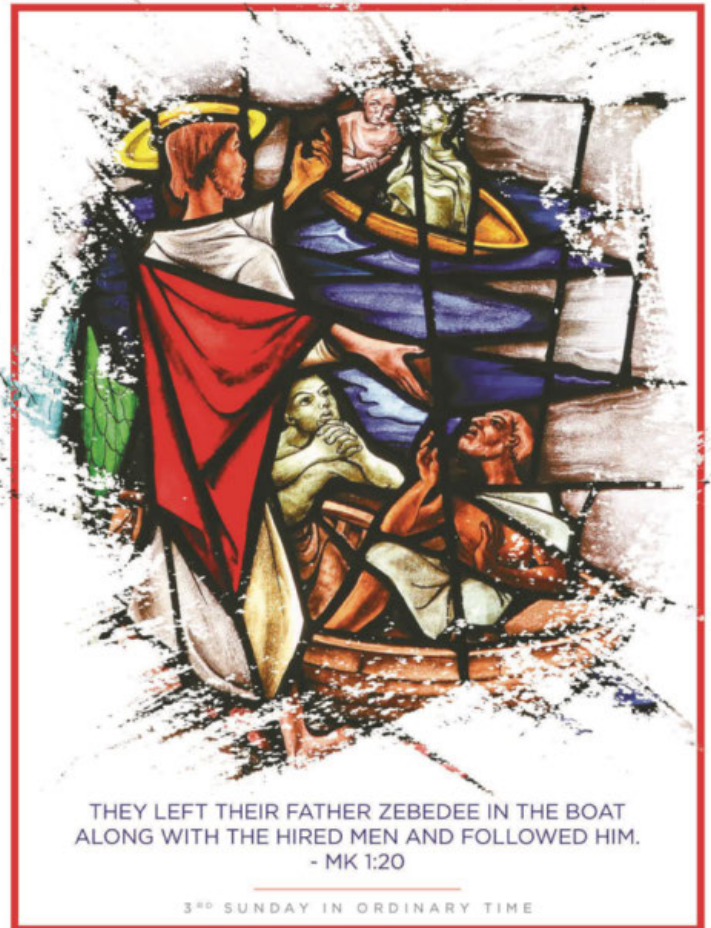

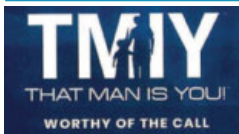
PANTRY FOOD COLLECTION

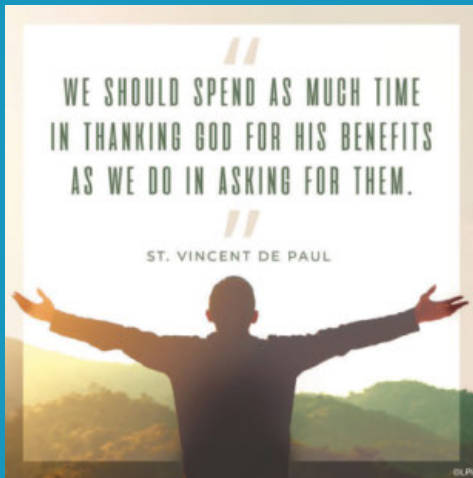
WOMEN'S BIBLE STUDY

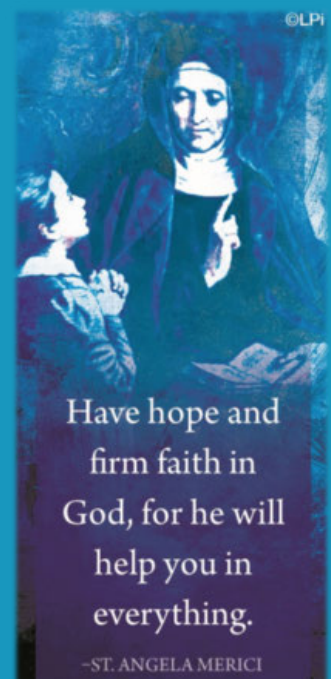

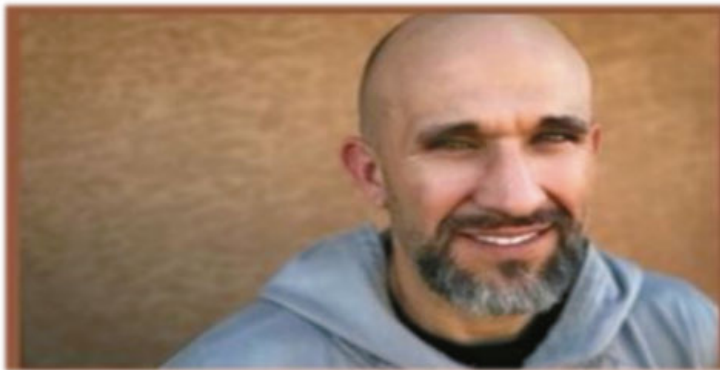
