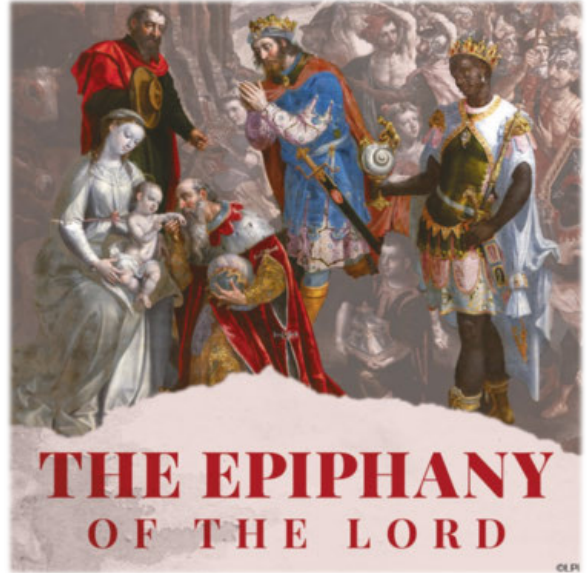

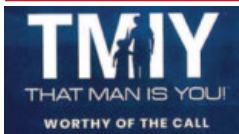
PANTRY FOOD COLLECTION

ANOINTING OF THE SICK

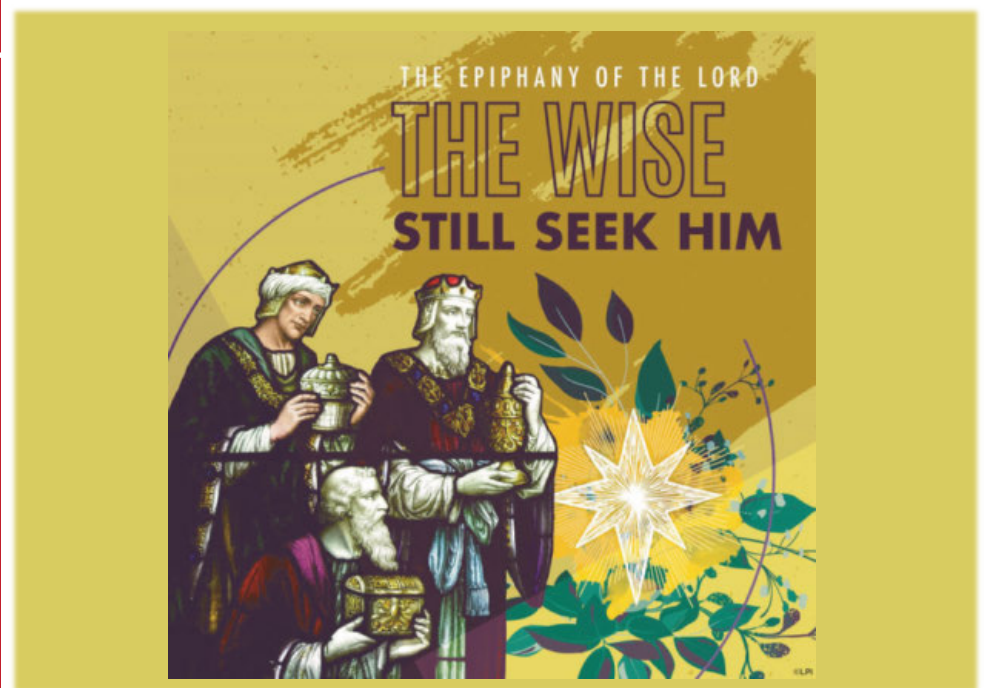

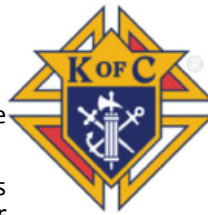
