Under the general direction of the Pastor and Director of Liturgy, the Sacristan undertakes the general preparation for the liturgical celebration.

Specific Duties:

- Prepare & set-up sacred vessels before Mass to which includes:
 - 1. Setting out the proper # of hosts
 - 2. Setting out the Presider's host
 - 3. Readying the wine
 - 4. Readying the lavabo, water, and towel; and
 - 5. Setting up the sacred vessels (chalice, paten(s), or ciboria) on the credence table according to the number needed

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- 6. Place wine cruet and bowl of hosts on Offertory table at back of church
- Set Roman Missal and place on Altar
- Set Lectionary and place on Ambo
- Prepare Presider's Binder to include:
 - 1. General Prayer Intentions; and
 - 2. Announcements
- Set Presider's Binder on table next to Presider's Chair
- Set General Prayer Intentions on Ambo
- Set Announcements on Ambo
- Ensure hand sanitizer containers are full and placed on table near altar for clergy and on table for EMs
- Obtain special instructions, if any, from Presider regarding Eucharistic Ministers
- Check-in Eucharistic Ministers using Planning Center app
- Inform alternate(s) of their need, if any, during Mass
- Provide any special instructions to Eucharistic Ministers before Mass begins; and
- Purify the sacred vessels after Mass.

General Maintenance:

- Keep Sacristy, Hallway and Storage areas unobstructed.
- Call out safety issues and hazards immediately to Pastor or Dir. of Liturgy.
- Keep Sacristy quiet. Non-essential persons are **not** permitted in the Sacristy.
- Secure Sacristy doors when last to leave.

Requirements:

- Regular parishioner of San Antonio de Padua Church
- Active member in good standing with Eucharistic Minister ministry
- Ability to communicate clear, understandable instructions to other
- Arrive 20 minutes before Mass; and
- Remain after Mass to properly store the sacred vessels (approximately 10 15 minutes).
